Holiday colors are encouraged. *If your child is a ballerina, please have your child wear black leggings/yoga pants and a red or green shirt. A tutu will be provided and can be tied around your child's clothing (it must be returned at the end of the concert). The concert is approximately 40 minutes long. For the safety of your children, we ask that you remain in your seats at the conclusion of the concert until grades K-3 have exited the gym to return to their assigned classrooms. Students in 4 th and 5 th grades will remain in the gym with their teachers. You may then pick your child up from their teacher at their assigned location.
